To Whom it May Concern:

Mora-San Miguel Electric Cooperative, Inc. was directed by U.S. Forest Service to de-energize power to the following areas for safety reasons due to the Calf Canyon/Hermits Peak wildfires:

Dates de-energized and restored:

Mora, La Cordillera East of 518: de-energized 05-01-22. Southern Parts were restored on 05-05-22, others not until 05-17-22.

Mora, La Cordillera West of 518: de-energized 05-01-22. Southern portion restored on 05-05-22 near Water Tanks. Upper/Northern portion restored on 5-17-22.

Cleveland, El Encinal, & Tramperos: de-energized 5-1-22, restored on 5-17-22.

Holman & Chacon: de-energized on 05-01-22. Holman restored on 05-17-22 up to Mile Marker 34. **Chacon and Upper/West Holman** restored on 05-23-22. **

El Alto, Chupaderos, Turquillo, & Guadalupita: de-energized 05-01-22; restored 05-18-22


Canoncito, La Cueva, Buena Vista, Golondrinas, & Cebollita: de-energized 05-01-22 to 05-05-22 exception*** Cebollita and Buena Vista de-energized on 04-22-22. Portions of Cebollita not restored until 05-13-22.

El Abuelo, Monte Aplanando, LeDoux, El Oro, South & North Carmen, & Las Aguitas: de-energized on 04-22-22; restored on 05-13-22.

Gascon, Rociada, & Maestas Canyon: de-energized on 04-22-22; restored on 05-17-22, portions of upper Gascon and Maestas Canyon not restored until 5-19-22. **

Tierra Monte, Manuelitas, Sapello, & Los Alamos areas: de-energized 04-22-22; restored on 05-09-22







Las Tusas, San Ignacio, Beulah Route, & Rincon Montoso areas: deenergized on 04-22-22; restored on 05-16-22 ** Some of these areas were also out between 04-12-22 and 04-15-22 in the early run of Hermit's peak fire prior to Calf Canyon joining. ** the Las Tusas area de-energized on April 12, 22 and power was restored on April 15, 2022. Then we were required once again to de-energize power on April 22, 2022 and then it was restored again on May 10, 2022.

Penasco Blanco & Pendaries: de-energized 04-22-22; restored on 05-16-22.

Gallinas, El Porvenir, & Trout Springs: Originally de-energized 04-12-22; restored on 04-15-22 early Hermits Peak run; de-energized again on 04-22-22 to present due to damaged poles off main feed from Las Dispensas into El Porvenir. Power will be out an estimated time of 30 days while contractors repair damaged infrastructure**

Christmas Tree Canyon, Sierra Bonita, Rincon Ranch, & Trumbull Canyon: de-energized on 05-1-22. Most Parts were restored on 05-18-22. Trumbull Canyon restored 05-23-22. Christmas Tree Canyon restored on 05-24-22.

Calf Canyon & Upper Gallinas Canyon were already de-energized due to severe wind storm on 12-09-21.
